Mr. MURKOWSKI (for himself, Mr. INHOFE, and Mr. ENZI) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation

A BILL

To establish age limitations for airmen.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AGE AND OTHER LIMITATIONS.**

4 (a) GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision
5 of law, beginning on the date that is 30 days after the
6 date of enactment of this Act—

7 (1) section 121.383(c) of title 14, Code of Fed-
8 eral Regulations, shall not apply;

9 (2) no certificate holder may use the services of
10 any person as a pilot on an airplane engaged in op-
11 erations under part 121 of title 14, Code of Federal

1 Regulations, if that person is 65 years of age or
2 older; and

3 (3) no person may serve as a pilot on an air-
4 plane engaged in operations under part 121 of title
5 14, Code of Federal Regulations, if that person is 65
6 years of age or older.

7 (b) CERTIFICATE HOLDER.—For purposes of this
8 section, the term “certificate holder” means a holder of
9 a certificate to operate as an air carrier or commercial
10 operator issued by the Federal Aviation Administration.

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
